Purpose of Position

The Early Head Start Teacher II works directly with infants and toddlers enrolled in the Early Head Start program. This position assists the Teacher I and cooperates in a supportive role carrying out developmentally appropriate activities. The Teacher II also promotes the health, nutrition and education of the children and attends to their safety and welfare.

Required Qualifications

- Associate's degree in Early Childhood Education or related degree with 21 credit hours of educational coursework related directly to child care and/or child development from birth to age 6, with a minimum of 3 semester hours focusing on the exceptional child.
- Must successfully complete a basic training course of 6 or more clock hours on providing care to children with disabilities that has been approved by DCFS and submit a certificate of completion to Human Resources.
- Have Illinois Gateways Infant/Toddler Credential.
- Must successfully complete Illinois Food Handler's card within 30 days of hire and maintain every 3 years.
- Must successfully obtain CPR and First Aid certification within 11 months of hire and maintain current certifications.
- Must pass a DCFS background check.
- Valid Illinois driver's license, automobile insurance, and reliable vehicle transportation.

Previous early childhood experience a plus.
