Program Overview

The Parent Ambassador Program is a year long peer to peer training program for Head Start and Early Head Start Parents. Parent Ambassadors will go through an extensive year long high quality advocacy training program.

Parents will be expected to learn the basics of government, about specific pieces of legislation, how to contact their lawmakers, how to provide effective testimony and how to effectively engage parents in their community.

After trainings, Ambassadors will be expected to take what they have learned and educate, train and mobilize parents back at their local programs and in their communities. Ambassadors will be expected to provide grassroots trainings at Parent Policy Council meetings in their area and to teach parents about pending legislation. They will provide frequent updates to parents in their local programs about legislative issues directly affecting their families and strategic opportunities to weigh in with federal elected officials. Ambassadors will also serve as lead organizers for IHSA advocacy campaign activities. Each selected Parent Ambassador will have a Parent Ambassador Coach. This coach will be someone who provides ongoing support and regular communication with their assigned Parent Ambassador. .

Position Description

We are looking for parents that are committed to advocating for their children and communities, serve in a leadership role at a local program, either through policy council or in another area, and have the desire and demonstrated skills to complete the year-long project.

Parent Ambassadors will receive:

↗ **\$100.00 Stipend for attending trainings Springfield. \$100 for each of 2 trainings, to be given upon completion of each training. (Total of stipends is @200.00)**

↗ **Travel expenses to/from Springfield, hotel, food, per diem and materials will be provided.**

↗ **Coaching and mentoring will be provided**
